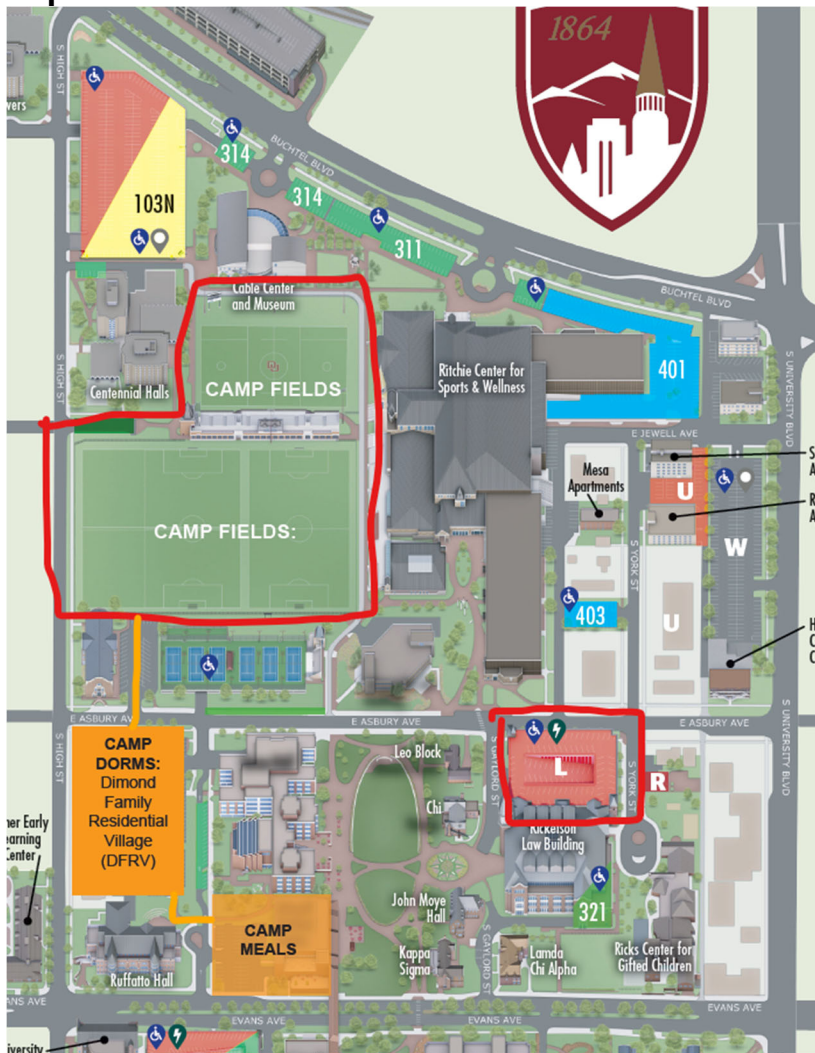
Peter Barton Stadium and Diane Wendt Fields
